

Enjoying your stay with us...

We ask that all guests be mindful of their fellow guest(s). Our site is peaceful, and for everyone's safety and comfort, please keep in mind the following site rules:

- As soon as you come through our gate, please abide by the **20km on-site speed** limit; there will always be farm animals and children to consider. Please be courteous to our wildlife residents.
- We ask that you avoid driving across plantation areas or unmarked areas in the farm, this is a working farm.
- Please respect nature we want everyone to engage with the beautiful land we have here at BietjieDam, but please just look and don't touch when it comes to birds' nests and plants. Please don't forage and eat any wild food.
- SMOKING is ONLY permitted in OUTDOOR AREAS. If you smoke outside, please do not drop your butts on the ground or decks.
- Please keep **noise down after 10:00pm**, for everyone's enjoyment of the peaceful environment.
- Check-in from 14:00 p.m. and check-out from 10:00 a.m. please.
- Please may we ask that leave our campsites neat and tidy when you leave.
- If you notice **any damage** to property during your stay, **please let us ASAP**.
- Please do not throw any **foreign objects or sanities** in the toilets, it will **block our** system.

If you have rented a Hot Tub for your campsite:

When you arrive, we will have *drained, scrubbed and re-filled* the tub *since the last guests.* Your hot tub will be lit and ready for use, subsequent bags of wood may be purchased from us. During your stay, we ask that you *please do not drain the water out after single use.* The hot tubs are designed to always have water in them, or they will spring a leak if they dry out. Also, it takes an incredible amount of water to fill it.

Extra care should be taken for children, anyone with a heart condition or high blood pressure – we would advise you keep the temperature lower. If you begin to feel lightheaded then get out and cool down!

Please *put the cover back on after use* to minimise falling debris getting in. Be prepared that you will always get some debris, and the water will get a bit dirty from people getting in and out during your stay. If it *gets really disgusting* give us a shout and *we'll come and drain, scrub and re-fill it.* The hot tub is for relaxing in rather than bathing, so *please do not use soap or shampoo in the tub*. We drain our hot tubs into the dam. Use at your own Risk.

Dam/Water safety

Please be aware, we have left the landscape as wild and unfenced as possible for everyone's enjoyment, so the responsibility for child safety and supervision is with you. There are very deep areas of water – so we ask that children are supervised at all times whilst in and around the dam. We do not have any swimming aids, so you must provide your own if children need them. Swimming in the dam is at your own Risk.

Farm Safety

Please do not enter the farmyard, farms are dangerous places and there is often large machinery being driven around.
