



Enjoying Your Stay at BietjieDam...

We kindly ask all guests to be mindful of fellow visitors. BietjieDam is a peaceful, working farm, and for everyone's safety and comfort, please take note of the following:

### **Speed Limit**

- Please keep to **30 km/h** once through the gate
- Watch out for farm animals, wildlife, and children

### **Farm & Nature Respect**

- Please do not drive through plantation or unmarked areas
- Enjoy nature, but do not touch birds' nests or plants
- No foraging or eating wild plants

### **Smoking**

- Smoking is allowed outdoors only
- Please dispose of cigarette butts responsibly

### **Noise**

- Quiet time from 10:00 pm onwards

### **Check-in / Check-out**

- **Check-in: 14:00**

(Applies to in season and long weekends, please contact us to make arrangements)

- **Check-out: 10:00**

(Applies to in season and long weekends, please contact us to make arrangements)

### **Departure**

- Please leave your campsite neat and tidy
- Report any damage to us as soon as possible

### **Electricity**

- ***Please note the whole of BietjieDam runs on solar power only — So, please be mindful of using electric kettles, heaters, and other devices that drain the batteries and kindly limit use of high-energy appliances.***
- **Geysers are gas** - start on hot water, once hot adjust to desired temperature. If your water is not getting hot contact, Justin to exchange the gas bottle.



### Water

- **Our mountain water** may not be crystal clear, **but it is safe to drink.**
- The **water from our taps** comes directly **from the mountains** (NOT the dam) and the **colour is a result of Capes Towns beautiful fynbos.**

### Toilets

- Please do not throw foreign objects or sanitary items into the toilets – this will block the system

### IMPORTANT

- Swimming and use of all BietjieDam facilities is at your own risk
- Hot Tub Guests – Please Note
  - Your tub is cleaned, refilled, and lit before arrival
  - Please do not drain the tub after use – it must always contain water
  - Additional firewood can be purchased
  - Replace the cover after use to keep debris out
  - No soap or shampoo allowed
  - If the water becomes very dirty, let us know and we'll assist
  - Children, heart conditions & high blood pressure: keep temperatures lower
  - Use of the hot tubs are at your own risk

### Dam / Water Safety

- The farm is unfenced and natural
- Children must be supervised at all times
- No swimming aids are provided – please bring your own
- Swimming is at your own risk

### Farm Safety

- Please do not enter the farmyard
- Heavy machinery may be in operation
